land, 265 acres of it, was donated by
Jeptha Wade (1811-1890) and has
become the final resting place for
102,000 soles while still having seventy
acres of burial sites available. Although
it is seven miles from the shore of Lake
Erie, the lake can be seen from its
highest elevation. Along with its long
list of famous residents is President
James A. Garfield. The president was
shot on July 2, 1881, in a Washington
railroad station, an embittered attorney
who had sought a consular post shot the
President. President Garfield died on
September 19, 1881. oo0oo
