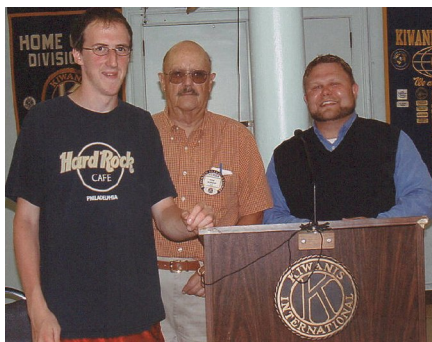
### *Don Wilkinson Receives K.I. Award*

Amendment 7 - International president as chairman of the board Action: Withdrawn. Amendment 8 - District representation on the Kiwanis International board. Action: Rejected. Amendment 9 - Regarding the use of the Kiwanis mark. Action: Rejected. Resolution 1 - Celebrating and fostering diversity. Action: Approved, amended to "Celebrating Inclusiveness". Resolution 2 Honoring Walter Sellers, past international president, upon his recent passing. Action: Approved
