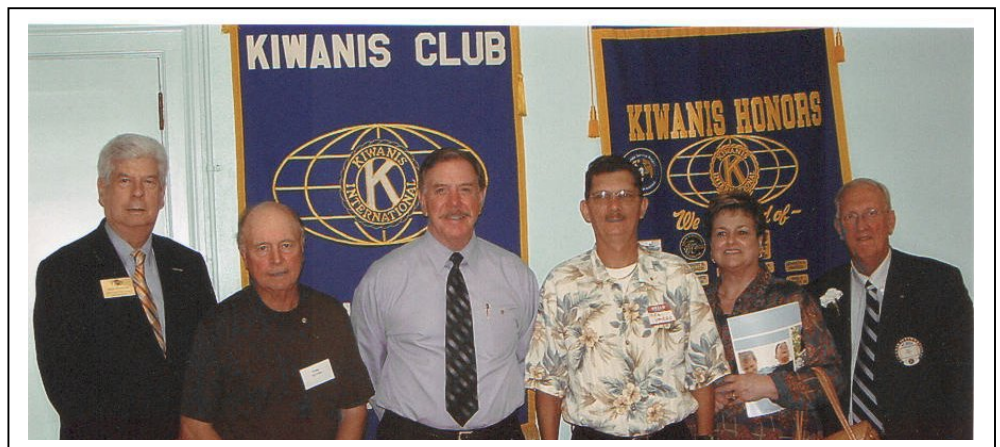
Dues Reminder
