*How Old is the Oldest?*

The oldest living tree has been found to be in Sweden's Dalarna Province, in a stand of 20 other spruces found to be more than 8,000 years old. The oldest tree was tested using the Carbon 14 test and was found to be 9,550 years old. That would make it a seedling about 7,500 B.C. The previous longest living trees were found in North America and were pines found to be about 5,000 years old.
