If there were errors in the last printing now is the time to have them corrected. So please, please let the Editor know NOW.

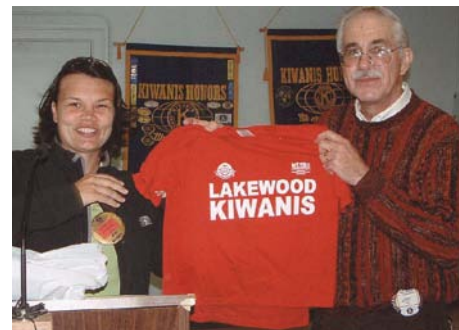
If you have an e-mail address and would like the Kiwanis-Gram sent to you so you would have it to view in color before the meeting, be sure to pass your request on also.
