children in the community through
Young Children Priority One, (YCPO).

Through the efforts of our Past
President John Wilson and the KCL
Board of Directors to expand service to
the community, our YCPO Committee
and its Chair, Toni Gelsomino has
brought to us a new program.

The Lakewood Foundation is
requesting a grant from the Ohio
District Kiwanis Foundation to help
financially support the program. In
addition, The Kiwanis Club of
Lakewood, Ohio, Inc. is the sponsor of
this program as is outlined in the grant
request.

The KCL is also being asked to
financially support the program and
more importantly is agreeing to
provide volunteers for the program.
This will be the point of new "service to
the community" and the point where
individual KCL members will have the
opportunity to serve in new ways.

Learn Through Play will be held at
the East End Family Room located in
Fedor Manor.

Program Goals:

1- Learn Through Play in the
East End Family Room will
incorporate volunteers recruited from
Lakewood Kiwanis Club to support
parent/caregiver and child family
literacy experiences.

2 - Learn Through Play will
target parents/caregivers raising
children through age 5 who are not in a
formal early care/education setting,
and/or are in need of supplemental
enrichment for school readiness or
success.

3 - Learn Through Play will
support the parent/caregiver to
identify and access community
resources, which meet basic needs,
improve self-sufficiency and decrease
isolation.
