Lakewood is working in support of
children in the community through
Young Children Priority One,
(YCPO).

TARGET POPULATION:

This project will target
parents/caregivers with children to age
five who are not in a formal early care
and education setting or who are in
need of enrichment to support school
readiness or success. Participants will
reside in the eastern end of Lakewood
with focused recruitment in the
Harrison Elementary School
neighborhood. Harrison's free/reduced
lunch count is the highest in
Lakewood's school system (82% of 388
children families are new to the school
this year.

Participants will be recruited through
Harrison school newsletters, Harrison
PTA and Lakewood Early Childhood
PTA. Flyers will be posted in local
government, businesses, library, and
community agencies. Faith
communities and direct personal
marketing will further publicize the
project. Learn Through Play
information will also be posted on the
City of Lakewood web site and
included on water bills distributed to
Lakewood homes.

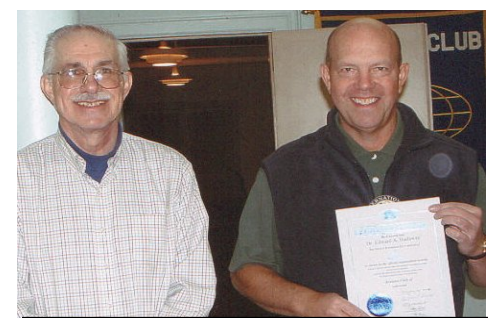
