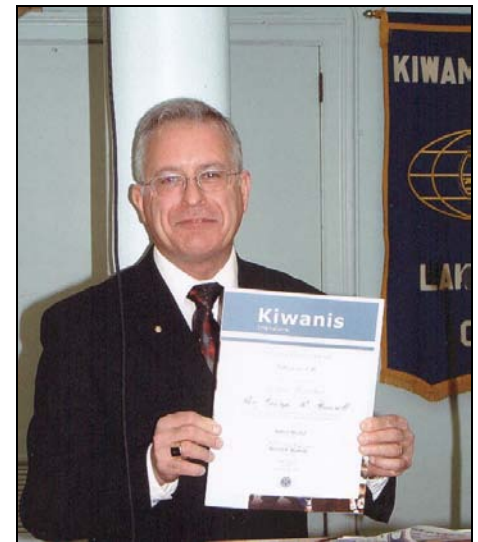

RS Form 990-N Required

The IRS has made changes in the filing requirements for small Tax-Exempt entities that will effect many Ohio District Kiwanis Clubs. The changes were the result of the Pension Reform Act of 2006. Historically non-profit organizations with revenues not exceeding \$25,000 have not filed tax returns with the Internal Revenue Service. The new requirements apply to tax periods beginning after December 31, 2006. What this means for Kiwanis Clubs is that it would apply to your tax year ending September 30, 2008.

>>>> President Andy Bischof opened the meeting by introducing our guests which included the return visit of eleven previous Scholarship recipients..... Matt Rawlings, Secretary of the Scholarship Foundation noted in the 50 plus years of existence, the Foundation had awarded 1.2 million dollars in scholarships. Matt then introduced each of college students. All are doing quite well in their studies in colleges and universities throughout the country. Several have spent some time studying abroad..... For the past several years Lakewood Kiwanis has been helping to support Adrienne Strong as she has been working in a medical mission in a government hospital in Tanzania. Tanzania is an East African country consisting of the former countries of Tanganyika and Zanzibar. Adrienne will be returning to Tanzania this fall. Of interest was the fact in that country the government pays all medical expenses for children to age 5 and for all pregnancies.....Our guest speaker, Mr. Robert Frost was introduced by "Tex" Phillips. Mr. Frost is one of four members of the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections. The Board consists of two Democrats and two Republicans. Mr. Frost is also Chairman of the county Republican Party. Currently there are 1,436 precincts within the county. The Board of Election cost per voting ballot is: Voting at the Board of Elections - \$20, Voting at the ward on Election Day - \$10, and voting by mail - \$5. Currently there are 21 Councilmen on the Cleveland City Council all are Democrats. Next year there will be an election for 19 Council seats. The City of Cleveland is currently operating with a balanced budget.
