Service Project. We invite you or your  
institution, association or organization  
to submit a proposal to us by October 1,  
2009, for consideration.

Kiwanis International is a not-for-  
profit global organization of  
volunteers working to change the  
world one child and one community  
at a time. The organization is  
membership-based and has  
approximately 600,000 adult and  
youth members worldwide.

Kiwanis successfully completed its  
first Worldwide Service Project  
virtually eliminating Iodine  
Deficiency Disorders (IDD).  
Kiwanis raised more than \$100  
million, which today is at work in  
more than 89 nations. The number  
of households estimated to be  
consuming iodized salt has jumped  
from 20 percent in 1990 to more  
than 70 percent, and the effort has  
been heralded as one of the most  
successful health initiatives in the  
world.
