Cost of KCL lunches has increased!

As you may already be aware, each week the, KCL is charged for a minimum number of lunches, whether or not we have that many members who will be dinning.

Only with an occasional exception do we meet that quota. Those extra meals are paid for at full cost to the KCL which is paid for from our Operating Fund Account. In so doing, the club is actually subsidizing the cost of each meal purchased. Additionally, the present operating income versus operating expense, in these financially difficult times, has helped place our Operating Account in a negative position. In order to help remedy this situation, which is in an early stage, the Board of Directors has approved an increase in the cost of each lunch meal to the point that members are asked to pay the true cost of each meal, that is, \$7.00. The board wishes to encourage members to have lunch at our meetings thereby further reducing the club's expense by not having to pay for uneaten lunches. The Board also hopes the members will understand and support this timely decision.

Further discussion of the matter will continue at today's Business Meeting.
